

SPECIAL ELECTIONS FOR THE SENATE DISTRICT 33 TO BE HELD JUNE 23 & JULY 21

On May 5, 2015 Governor Walker called for a special election to be held in Senate District 33, which was vacated by Paul Farrow who is the newly elected Governor. The election is needed and will be Tuesday, June 23, followed by the general election on July 21.

June 23 Primary Election Dates To Remember:

Any requests voters have on file for "All 2015 Election" must be filed by June 19 at 5pm. Current Voter ID is on file. In-person absentee voting will be held on June 23 at 5pm.

July 21 General Election Dates To Remember:

Any requests voters have on file for "All 2015 Election" must be filed by July 17 at 5pm. Current Voter ID is on file. In-person absentee voting will be held on July 21 at 5pm.
